- 1. Opening Comments and Introductions. Chairman Creasy welcomed all in attendance.

3. Review Agency Reports

Accounting Division

Patrick Fisk presented the financial report for the period of July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023. **Attachment 1**

National Poultry Improvement Plan (NPIP)

Kevin Simmons, NPIP Coordinator, presented the NPIP summary report for December 2022 – February 2023. Simmons highlighted YTD totals:

•	VS 9-3 forms certified for eggs, chicks, & poults:	2,615

Simmons stated they have completed 4 company inspections, 12 processing plant

inspections, 4 hatchery inspections, 1 Biosecurity audit and 1 NPIP Lab audits in the last quarter.

Egg and Poultry Report

School Lunch Commodities

Cheri Ellis, Agri Division Manager, reported the Commodity Contracts that were awarded effective July 1, 2023:

- Butterball, Huntsville 180,000 pounds of whole birds
- George's Cassville 910,000 pounds of whole birds, this facility is continually adding contracts after previous contracts are fulfilled
- OK Foods, Muldrow, OK 468,000 pounds of consumer split breasts
- OK Foods, Ft. Smith 6,000,000 pounds of leg quarters
- Tyson Foods, Broken Bow, OK 2,400,000 pounds of drumsticks
- Tyson Foods, Gadsden, AL 1,500,000 pounds of fajita strips
- Tyson, Waldron 646,000 pounds of cut-up product

Auditing

Audits completed for Fiscal Year 2023:

- Food Defense: 41
- Child Nutrition: 8 with a total of 2,608,400 pounds produced
- United Egg Producers: 4
- Cage Free Verification Program: 4
- Contractor Check Loading Verification: 9

Ellis reported the Fiscal Year 2023 volume production:

- 1,231,821,271 lbs. of chicken
- 1,099,989,065 lbs. of turkey
- 12,834 lbs. of rabbit
- 4,423,206 / 30 dz. cs. of shell eggs

Ellis reported on the retail inspections this Fiscal Year:

- 2,100 retail location inspections
- 475,080 dozen cartons of product for labeling and grade requirements
- 5 warnings for non-Permitted packers

- 24 warnings issued for failure to meet grade requirements
- 507 dozen cartons were placed on Stop Sale

Livestock Field and Flea Markets Report

Blake Walters, Program Manager, presented the field activities for April – June 2023. Walters highlighted the importance of electronic ID for cattle. The benefits of the electronic tags will help the industry as well as protect it.

Meat Inspection Program

Tillman Treat, Meat Inspector, reported two plants have been approved and continue to be inspected. Williams Baptist University has submitted their HACCP plan and anticipates starting production in August. Treat stated they are working with plants in Altus, Monticello, and Melbourne to get their HACCP plans approved. All custom exempt inspections have been completed for the year.

Field Services Report

Administrative

Dr. John Nilz, State Veterinarian, reported they are moving forward with selecting an electronic Certificated of Veterinary Inspection (eCVI) system. The goal of this component is to provide this as a free service for in-state veterinarians and employees. Dr. Nilz stated negotiations are currently taking place.

Diseases

- Staff assisted the Arkansas Veterinary Medical Association with response to concerns about Canine Influenza
- There have been 2 positive cases of rabies in cattle. In the central and south-central parts of the state. 1 herd has been released after a 40-day quarantine.
- 6 cases of Trichomoniasis 2 cases were bull only and 4 cases were cows.

4. General Activities

Patrick Fisk, Director, Livestock and Poultry Division, introduced guest speaker Glen Hoffsis, Founding Dean for College of Veterinary Medicine at A-State. Dr. Hoffsis stated the shortest projected timeframe for veterinary classes to start is approximately 2 years with a projected class size of 100-125 students.

Fisk introduced the next guest speaker Dr. Eleanor Green, Founding Dean of Lyon College School of Veterinary Medicine. Dr. Green stated the projected date of their first veterinary class is fall of 2025 with a projected class size of 100-120 students.
