PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS COME - GREETINGS:

WHEREAS: Arkansas is considered the birthplace of warm water aquaculture, beginning

with the first commercial fish farms built in the 1940s for goldfish production, and is considered the birthplace of the commercial catfish industry with the first

farm-raised catfish sales in the late 1950s;

WHEREAS: Aquaculture is an important sector of Arkansas' broad and diverse agricultural

industry that contributes more than \$20.9 billion to Arkansas's economy

annually as the state's top industry;

WHEREAS: Arkansas catfish farmers contributed \$20.6 million to Arkansas' agricultural

economy in foodsize fish sales in 2023;

WHEREAS: Arkansas catfish producers had more than 8 million foodsize fish in inventory on

January 1, 2024;

WHEREAS: Arkansas has 3,100 water surface acres used for catfish production in 2024;

WHEREAS: Arkansas enacted a catfish labeling law in 2015 to ensure consumers can

accurately identify the country of origin of catfish purchased in Arkansas retail

establishments.

WHEREAS: Arkansas ranks 3rd nationally in foodsize fish sold at 16,600,000 pounds; and

WHEREAS: Arkansas is home to excellent programs to provide research and support to the

aquaculture industry, including the Arkansas Department of Agriculture Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory in Little Rock, the Aquaculture/Fisheries Center for Excellence at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, and the USDA Agriculture Research Service's Harry K. Dupree National Aquaculture Research

Center in Stuttgart.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SARAH HUCKABEE SANDERS, Governor of the State of Arkansas, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Arkansas, do hereby proclaim August 2024 as

"CATFISH MONTH IN ARKANSAS"
