

The Local Food, Farms, and Jobs Act (Local Food Act) was enacted in 2017 and amended in 2019 to create, strengthen, and expand local farm and food economies throughout the state. The Local Food Act <u>requires</u> institutions to set a goal of at least 20% of their food budget to be spent on local food and <u>requires</u> institutions to provide information on their local food procurement budget.

Getting Started

Complete the form below to report your institution's activities related to the Local Food, Farms, and Jobs Act for fiscal year 2024 (FY2024.) FY2024 began on July 1, 2023 and ended on June 30, 2024.

Before completing the form, it is recommended that you first review a PDF copy of the full reporting form and gather any records or documentation that will aid you in filling out the data required by the form.
